

Faculty Guide to Course Evaluations


Student course evaluations help faculty gain a better understanding of how well they are meeting the learning needs of their students. Student feedback helps faculty determine elements of course instruction, curriculum, and delivery that are working well or need to be improved. Student course evaluations occur at the end of each course, regardless of course length, and have the following added benefits.

- Students can reflect on their learning experience in the course. This includes what they
 have learned in the course and what elements of course instruction, content, or delivery
 worked or did not work for them. This helps students make better decisions when
 selecting future classes or exploring options for a program of study.
- Candid course evaluations help faculty understand what is working or what needs
 improvement with their teaching, course organization, course content, or course
 delivery. Course evaluation can also provide insight on how well the instructor addressed
 stated course and/or program learning outcomes.
- Course improvements based on student course evaluations benefit future students with a better learning experience. Course evaluations do factor into faculty advancement & tenure decisions.


The Course Evaluation Portal

The new Snow College Course Evaluation Portal will contain an Instructor Dashboard. If you are a student taking classes at Snow College, you will also see a list of currently enrolled courses to evaluate.

The Instructor Dashboard will provide each faculty member with

- 1. A link to access their course evaluations.
- A summary report of evaluations completed against student enrollment for each active term course. This summary report will only appear during the active evaluation period during which reporting is disabled.

In addition, Snow College provides a <u>public dashboard of semester Couse Evaluation</u> <u>results</u>. This dashboard includes institutional trend data, department response percentages, and individual faculty course response rates.



Clicking on the Course Evaluation Reporting link will take you to your Course Evaluation page, defaulted to the current term. From that page you can use the search and navigation options to view previous term evaluations, evaluations with comparative averages, and export evaluation results to Excel.
