Welcome to [Snow College's Commercial Driver's License!](#) Snow College's provides professional driver training with both classroom theory discussion and in-vehicle hands-on training time. This course is designed to meet the Entry-Level Driver Training (ELDT) requirements set forth by the Federal Motor Carrier Administration (FMCSA) and the Utah Department of Transportation (DOT). Students will complete a range of driver competencies and become safe, comfortable, confident, law-abiding drivers. Students will become prepared to take the State of Utah driving skills tests for the Class A combination vehicle such as a tractor & trailer with air brakes.

If a CDL license holder moves to another state, the license holder will typically need to transfer the CDL to the new state. Usually, the CDL license holder will not need to redo testing in the new state, but there may be new CDL license transfer fees. Snow College students are advised to complete their CDL coursework and take the CDL testing here in Utah before moving to another state.

Each state has set their own standards for licensure that are independent of graduating from Snow College. States may require additional course work or professional training.
